

Before and After School Routines

Morning

- Supervision is from 8:30am
- Students line up at 8:55am
- Notes placed in the office 'Note Box' before school
- Students are encouraged to go to the toilet before class starts



Getting Home

Afternoon

- Each afternoon, students line up in 4 different lines: bus, Olive Street, Kiss and Ride and After School Care. Teachers walk these groups down.
- Pick up time is 3pm
- Students forget easily when there is a change in their schedule.
 Please ensure your child knows how they are getting home each day.

Olive St is only for pedestrians. If you are driving, you must go via Kiss & Ride (Darcy Road) or park on neighbouring streets and walk to Olive St.

Google Classroom




- Google Classroom is an online collaboration tool, allowing students and teachers to work together on tasks, or simply to share information. It is a safe environment, monitored by teachers. Students can only join a classroom if the teacher explicitly shares a specific code. Students are likely to be members of several Google Classrooms created by teachers for class tasks and for homework assignments.
- Supported by the Department of Education NSW and can be accessed directly through the student portal.

Homework

- All Stage 1 homework will be available on Google Classroom each fortnight. They log into the student portal at home using their Department of Education username and password
- Students can ask teachers at school if they need assistance with their username or password.
- Homework will be fortnightly
- 'Must do' activities are reading, Maths,
- spelling, writing and speaking/listening. 'Can do' activities differ each fortnight but may include Science, Art, History etc. These are **optional**.
- If you have questions during the fortnight, please contact the teachers through the office and not in the comment section of Google Classroom.

Homework will start in Week 6. Teachers will take students through the homework at school. Students will be shown how to use Google Classroom.



Students will click 'turn in' when they have finished their homework.

Reading with your child at home document

If a student starts reading for 20 minutes per night in Kindergarten, by the end of Year 6 they would have read for the equivalent of 60 school days. If they read for 5 minutes per day, they would have read for 12 school days. If they read for 1 minute a day, the student would have read for 3 school days.





Physical activity recommends for children to engage in at least 30 minutes of physical activity each day.
